Technical Assistance Grant (TAG) provides services through the Statewide Field Team (SWFT) to districts with schools identified for Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI), Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI), or Additional Targeted Support (ATS). The mission of the SWFT is to develop the capacity of leaders to cultivate and sustain systems-based, data-driven organizations that provide an equitable education to each student. Technical assistance and professional learning are tailored to the needs of each district and are grounded in the foundational research of the Blueprint framework which includes the implementation of systems, routines, and practices that have been shown to have a positive impact on student achievement.
